Tour of the Stoddartsville Historic Center & Cemetery

HATT members were the guests of the Stoddartsville Historic Center and the Stoddartsville Preservation Society (SPS) on June 9, 2016. Hosted by SPS and HATT members Gene Kerrick and Kim Kerrick, 22 HATT members enjoyed the remarkable history of this village during four scheduled tours throughout the day.

The Center was recently remodeled, with refreshed and new displays, this past year. It expertly tells the history of Stoddartsville, in exceptional detail of its significant history in the 19th century, and well into the 20th century. Many artifacts show how life was lived during those years.

There are few history centers and museums that possess the detail expressed in the displays, that is exhibited at the Stoddartsville Historic Center.

Following the tour of the Center, HATT members enjoyed a walk through the Stoddartsville historic cemetery, where the founders of Blakeslee, Stoddartsville and Buck Township are buried, along with the community's Civil War veterans.
